



The Redemptions 6:30PM **THURSDAY NIGHT MAIN STAGE**

The Redemptions are a vocal trio who have been sharing their blend of traditional, progressive and southern gospel music with the local church and weekend audiences for more than three decades. Based in the St. Louis Missouri area the group travels by invitation across denominational lines to present a clear vision of the GOSPEL.

Their mission in concert is to create a sense of community that brings everyone together to a point where God can minister through music to the needs of those listening.

Formed in 1990 the group consists of alto Rindy Nehrkorn, soprano Deb Griffin and lead Kevin Womble.

The Redemptions are available for concerts, church services, revivals, civic functions and other special events.



Ray was born in Eustis, Florida. He was inspired by his grandfather Amos "Wilson" Roach, who played music for him and taught him how to play guitar, in addition to having him perform at assisted living centers. Ray chose to form a band in southern Florida after graduating high school, and a disc jockey at WPCV began playing his music. He independently released an album in 2010, which was

discovered by manager Tony Conway.

Ray was mentored by John Rich of Big & Rich on the singing competition The Next: Fame Is at Your Doorstep, which he won. He and Rich co-wrote Big & Rich's 2015 single, "Run Away with You". After winning the competition, Ray was signed to Warner Bros. Records Nashville. His first EP, Tour Bootleg, was released in 2014. Two of the EP's

tracks, "Kiss You in the Morning" (which went to number one on the Country Airplay charts in 2015) and "Think a Little Less," would later appear on his selftitled second album, released in 2015, becoming Ray's first and third singles, respectively. The track "Real Men Love Jesus" was named as Ray's second single. Ray supported the album with a tour.

On June 16, 2017, Ray re-

leased the single "Get to You" ahead of his third studio album, Amos. Upon the album's release in 2018, it would produce two more singles: "One That Got Away" and "Her World or Mine." Both of his albums were produced by Scott Hendricks.

In September 2020, Ray released the single "Whiskey and Rain" ahead of his fourth studio album, originally set to be released in 2021.




