

# Lit OHS Field greets Dutchgirl nine in 2021

Let there be light.

That saying will become reality this fall for Hannah Koppelmann's Owensville Dutchgirl softball team after new light fixtures were installed around OHS Field over the summer.

Fall Sports Preview

This will guarantee full junior varsity games instead of racing against the setting sun.

"I'm happy that our underclassmen will get to play more innings instead of being at the mercy of the setting sun," Koppelmann said.

Putting 17 notches in the win column last fall, OHS will look to add to that number behind the leadership of four seniors.

They include pitcher Addison Wright, center fielder Paige Loyd, shortstop Anna Finley and left fielder Leah Reed. "We have a great group of seniors that I will lean on to help coach up the younger players as the season goes on," Koppelmann said.

April Jahnsen is the lone junior on the Dutchgirl softball team for 2021 and will likely land at second base.

With only five upperclassmen, the majority of Koppelmann's diamond squad will consist of 17 underclassmen.

Sophomores making up the majority of the team include Grace Abell, Sophia Steinbeck, Jessalyn Farris, Layni Heidbreder, Emma Daniels, Isabella Pratt, Anya Binkhoelter, Hannah Nelson, Emily Krause and Kate Blankenship.

Freshmen rounding out the 2021 Dutchgirl softball roster include Alison Daniels, Caidence Goodman, Hannah Berkaw, Katie Loyd, Savannah Knight, Brynn Wright and Bailee Dare.

"Having a lot of underclassmen can be a good thing," Koppelmann said. "It means that they will have a chance at varsity innings before they become upperclassmen later in their high school careers."

Without a (Four Rivers) conference or district title for nearly two decades, the Diamond Dutchgirls will be looking to end one or both of those droughts.

"We've been working hard on building up our program the last few years and we hope to see a conference or district title come out of that," Koppelmann said.

Owensville will start their season this weekend in the Peoples Bank Back to School Softball Classic hosted by Sullivan High School at the Campbell-Chapman Sports Complex located off of Route D near Missouri Baptist-Sullivan Hospital.

Their first chance to possibly play under the lights at OHS Field will take place on Thursday, Sept. 2 when Linn's Lady Wildcats make the short trip to Owensville to take on the Dutchgirls.

# **Dutchgirl spikers eye first-ever FRC title**

Winning their first district title in volleyball since the Jimmy Carter administration, Jamie Ridenhour's Owensville Dutchgirl volleyball team would like to make another addition or two to their banner hanging in the rafters of the Owensville High School gym.

Now with two district titles to their credit (1979 and 2020), Ridenhour's Dutchgirl spikers would now like to add their first-ever Four Rivers Conference (FRC) title to the banner in addition to a third district title.

"Getting to add a district title to our banner felt amazing last fall," Ridenhour said. "Now we want to go after our first (Four Rivers) conference title in program history."

Made up of entirely upperclassmen, Ridenhour's varsity Dutchgirl volleyball squad consists of five seniors and six juniors.

Seniors looking to add a FRC title to their district title from last fall include Keira Hendrix, Kyla Hendrix, Anna Heidbrink and Olivia Vandegriffe.

Cheering the football team on last fall, Kayden Wood decided to trade in her pom pons for a volleyball to start her final year of high school.

Juniors getting a taste of varsity action as sophomores last fall include Molly Wnuk, Kylie Kitchen, Josie Gerlemann, Harley Pyrtle and Payton Boyd.

Gerlemann would certainly like nothing more than to add a conference-championship clinching kill after ending over four decades of waiting last fall for Owensville's second district title in program history.

Misti Rutledge's junior varsity team will consist of seven sophomores and a trio of freshmen to start the season.

Sophomores on the JV Dutchgirl volleyball roster include Hannah Stoker, Ayla Schmanke, McKenzy Echols, Ally Gooch, McKenna Edwards, Makensy Pigg and Elise McFalls.

Freshmen selected to the JV squad include Brynn Wright, Callie Koelling and Addi Menz.

For Wright, volleyball won't be her only fall sport as she will also be participating in softball whenever the schedules permit. Taylor Payne's Dutchgirl freshmen vol-



Holding their preseason jamboree last night (Tuesday) in Sullivan against the host Lady Eagles and Potosi Lady Trojans, Dutchgirl volleyball will open their season Monday, Aug. 31 on the road in Osage County against Linn's Lady Wildcats.

OHS will open the home portion of their schedule on Thursday, Sept. 2 hosting Capital City's Lady Cavaliers out of Jefferson City in the Owensville High School main gym.

Owensville will begin their quest for their first FRC title on Tuesday, Sept. 21 against Hermann's Lady Bearcats on the road after additional non-conference matches against Belle, Washington, Fatima and Rolla prior to that.

In addition to the Fulton Tournament the second weekend of September, Dutchgirl volleyball will compete in other varsity tournaments at Hermann during the final full week of September before quickly turning around and participating in the Rolla Volleyball Tournament on Saturday, Oct. 2 in Phelps County.

# Gridiron Dutchmen enter 2021 with 15 returning starters

#### Loaded.

That is one way to describe Nathan Cabot's Owensville Dutchmen football team entering the upcoming 2021 season.

That is because they return nine starters on offense and six starters on defense.

"We have a lot of experienced guys returning on both sides of the ball," Cabot said.

Among those nine starters on offense are a number of returning All-Four Rivers Conference (FRC) players.

Quarterback Brendan Decker is the reigning FRC Offensive Player of the Year and would not mind duplicating that feat this fall.

Throwing for 2,213 yards and 32 touchdowns last year, the Dutchmen signal caller also ran for 486 yards and three more scores during his junior season.

Decker will have three solid returners at wide receiver to throw to.

Leading the way is senior Derek Brandt who amassed 1,251 yards receiving last fall while also catching 14 touchdown passes.

Brandt became just the second Dutchmen wide receiver to surpass 1,000 yards in a single season alongside Matt Angell.

Other returning wide receivers for the Dutchmen include fellow senior Landon Valley and junior Bryce Payne.

An All-FRC second team wide receiver last fall, Payne racked up 430 yards receiving to go along with 10 touchdowns through the air.

Leading the ground attack with 379 yards rushing and six touchdowns last fall as a junior, senior Austin Lowder will look to end his Dutchmen football career with a 1,000 yard season.

Protecting these guys will be a strong, experienced offensive line.

Anchoring the O-line will be senior Logan Evans and junior Chance Clevenger. Evans is a returning All-FRC first team offensive lineman while Clevenger was an All-FRC second team offensive lineman

last fall.

Junior lineman Trey Johnson and sophomore Hayden Shoemaker also figure to be major pieces on the Dutchmen O-line.

Under defensive coordinator Dustin Howard, the Dutchmen defense will look to cause havoc to opposing offenses every Friday night.

Last fall, the Dutchmen defense limited opponents to 19.7 points, 190.5 rushing yards and 89.5 passing yards per game.

Looking to help them improve those numbers will be an experienced group of returners.

Also a potent weapon on offense at wide receiver, Brandt will be equally as dangerous on defense at safety.

Among the team leaders in tackles (81) and interceptions (2), Brandt will look to equal if not improve on those numbers this fall.

Once he returns from a shoulder injury,

Valley figures to also impact the Dutchmen secondary as a another safety after recording 35 tackles last fall.

Also an All-FRC receiver last fall, Payne will look to shutdown opposing receivers at cornerback after picking up 29 tackles and two interceptions a year ago.

An All-FRC first team offensive lineman last year, Evans will prove to be equally as dangerous on the defensive line.

He led the team with eight sacks on a defensive line that will look to cause nightmares for opposing offenses.

If Matt Candrl's Owensville Dutchmen and Dutchgirl cross country teams want to start another string of Four Rivers Conference (FRC) titles, they'll have to do it with a mixture of upperclassmen and underclassmen.

That is because the majority of both the Dutchmen and Dutchgirl cross country squad are made up of sophomores and younger.

One tough task will be replacing Mekayla Gibson who ended her OHS Cross Country career as an All-State harrier before committing to William Woods University to continue her academic and athletic pursuits.

Seniors looking to step up into a leadership role will include Kiera Finn, Mercedes Baguio, Hayden Loeb and Kyah Weirich.

Rounding out the upper classmen portion

of the Dutchgirl cross country roster will be Ella Gehlert and Saylor Richardson.

Gehlert capped her sophomore year helping the Dutchgirl 4x800-meter relay team qualify for the Missouri State High School Activities Association (MSHSAA) Track and Field Championships over the Memorial Day holiday weekend.


After COVID-19 forced them to race closer to home, OHS cross country will be able to race where they were going to last year.
