

# **Kemp takes over OHS** baseball

That will be the case this spring for Owensville Dutchmen baseball as they defend their district title from last season.

Graduating 12 seniors from a team that went 11-11-1 while ending OHS' 41-year district title drought, this year's Dutchmen will see a new head coach with Steven Kemp moving from the first base coaches box over to the third-base coaches box.

Tyler Ahring resigned his head baseball coaching position after last season to spend more time with his growing family and continues to teach TV Studio at Owensville High School.

"I'm looking forward to the challenge of defending our district title," Kemp said. "We'll have a number of guys that will be competing for varsity playing time and I'm

confident they will pick things up as the season progresses."

Seniors looking to lead the Dutchmen to back-to-back district titles include Austin Long, JJ Brown, Will Lauth and Wyatt Kramme.

Juniors rounding out the upperclassmen portion of the roster include Laine Baumbach, Landon Ely, Layne Evans and Logan Kleekamp.

Sophomores making up the majority of the Owensville Dutchmen varsity baseball roster include Elias Medlock, Logan Bailey, Landon Kramme, Matt Eckelkamp, Zaiden Gates, Jaden Gerlemann and Jansen Loeb.





# **Eight Dutchgirl soccer seniors**

Reaching double digits in victories for the fourth consecutive season finishing last spring at 12-15, Kalyn Kemp's Owensville Dutchgirl soccer squad has plenty of upperclassmen to help them make run at a fifth straight season with double digit wins.

Making up nearly half of the roster will be seniors Maria Benson, Drew Copeland, Landry Watson, Molly Wnuk, Kylie Kitchen, Mallory Eberlin, Avery Bastunas and Kiana Guerrero.

Hampered by a knee injury towards the end of her junior season, Watson enters her senior campaign a mere 18 goals from becoming the first 100-goal scorer in Dutchgirl soccer history.

Undergoing rehab, Watson is optimistic to soon be released to begin her senior

season on the pitch and her pursuit of triple digits in the goal-scoring department.

Rounding out the upperclassmen portion of the roster will be six Dutchgirl juniors in Jayna Larsen, Emily Krause, Anya Binkhoelter, McKenna Edwards, Audrey Quilacio and Hannah Nelson.

Krause and Nelson will be sharing time at goal keeper after Paige Loyd did most of the net minding before graduating last spring.

Lily Reed and Katie Loyd are the lone sophomores on the roster after being able to play their respective freshman seasons with older siblings Leah (Reed) and Paige).

Making their high school soccer debut as freshman this spring will be the Dutchgirl duo of Brooke Jahnsen and Clara Julius.

After opening their season last Friday on the road against Fatima's Lady Comets in Westphalia, Kemp's Dutchgirls began

Owensville will cap the first full week of their season with a road match at St. Clair last night (Tuesday) in addition to home matches later this week against Union tomorrow (Thursday) and Fulton on Friday before competing in the Chris Hotop Classic at Mexico High School.


Until then, the Dutchgirls will have road matches against Blair Oaks, Belle, Dixon, St. Francis Borgia and Wright City.

That is what awaits head coach Matt Candrl for the upcoming season of Owensville High School (OHS) Track and Field both for the Dutchmen and Dutchgirls.

Fresh off a state championship in the 110-meter hurdles, Dutchmen senior Bryce Payne will look to repeat in that event in addition to helping the orange and black in other events.

"Bryce (Payne) looks really good at this point in the spring and will make an immediate impact in the hurdles picking up where he left off from a year ago," Candrl said.

Other returning All-State athletes for the Dutchmen include seniors Charlie Whelan and Gabe Soest.

Both of them earned All-State honors for their legs of the Dutchmen 4x200 and 4x400-meter relays.

Junior Tanner Meyer was also on both teams.

A returning state qualifier in the 1600-meter run, junior Felix Guerrero figures to help the Dutchmen in distance events along with senior cross country state qualifier Lucas Morgan.

"With the same district assignments as last year, I look for us to be very competitive in both the boys and girls," Candrl said.

Dutchmen seniors joining Payne, Soest, Whelan and Morgan include Noah Holtmeyer, Derrick Marquez, Jaiden Mason and Aries Nicholas.

Juniors on the Dutchmen track and field roster in addition to Meyer and Guerrero include Umberto Bertesi, Jordan Bialczyk, Luis Delong, Blake Elliott, Layne Evans, Keontrae Gates, Ethan Harris, Braydan McDaniel, Hayden Shoemaker and Jesse Wiegel.

Dutchmen Field will play host to a pair of home meets throughout the regular season with the first being a quad meet on Tuesday, April 4.


Ten days later, the annual OHS Relays will take place on Friday, April 14 with at least 10 other schools converging onto the R-2 Campus.

Owensville Golf Course will play host to a pair of home meets for the orange and black on Thursday, April 13 against Hermann and on Monday, April 17 against Pacific.




